ALUMNI CAREER OUTCOMES **BY THE NUMBERS**

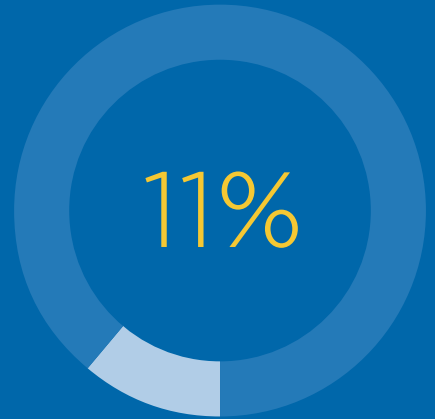
What's the career outlook for recent Driehaus College of Business graduates? Here's what the DePaul Career Center found in its **Class of 2013 career outcomes** survey conducted at commencement and again six months later:



DePaul master's degree recipients in full-time jobs who **secured positions directly related to their fields of study**



Business baccalaureate graduates who were **employed or in graduate school**, the highest rate since 2009



DePaul business graduates who chose **self-employment or entrepreneurship** for their career path, up from 8 percent in 2012
