ALL FOR DEPAUL

At the beginning of the 2013-14 academic year, DePaul kicked off All for DePaul, an alumni participation challenge. The university hopes to achieve 9,000 alumni donors by June 30.

The focus on participation is intentional and significant. "This challenge asks alumni to show their support for DePaul at any level that is comfortable for them," explains Tracy Krahl (CMN '95, LAS MS '09), assistant vice

president of alumni engagement. "By participating, alumni can share their pride in being a DePaul graduate and inspire others to give back."

When alumni join together, their combined generosity can make a real impact. Publications such as U.S. News and World Report consider alumni participation rates in their rankings, and foundations and other grant-making institutions also evaluate alumni giving rates in their major gift decisions. Strong participation among DePaul graduates can indicate a high sense of alumni satisfaction, which reflects positively on the university and enhances the value of a DePaul degree.

Gifts from alumni provide scholarships to students who would otherwise be unable

to attend DePaul, whose voices and talents enhance the university experience for fellow students and faculty. Alumni support furthers programs and improves facilities, helping DePaul to attract and retain top-notch faculty. Each gift from a graduate is an affirmation of the university's mission to serve the underserved, to engage with local and global communities, and to continue a tradition of excellence.
