## **Finding aids for *Annales de la Congrégation de la Mission***

1834-1885: *Tables Générales* (Paris, 1886)

A first attempt at arranging information from the first fifty years of the *Annales*, presented by countries in continental order. An alphabetical index closes the volume. It is superseded by subsequent indices.

1834-1899: *Repertoire Historique*, [first edition] (Paris, 1900)

More than an index, this work of Alfred Milon, C.M. begins with lists: superiors general, of the Congregation of the Mission and the Daughters of Charity, general assemblies of the CM; houses and biographical notices of the members of the CM; acts of the Holy See concerning the two congregations. The main part of the volume organizes references to individual countries, arranged by continents. An alphabetical index facilitates the use of this volume.

1834-1913: *Repertoire Historique*, second edition (Paris, 1914)

Alfred Milon, C.M., continued and corrected his work of 1900, adding information up through volume 78 (1913) of the *Annales*. It was never completed, stopping on p. 200; it exists only in individual fascicles occasionally bound with the *Annales*.

1834-1937: *Table Alphabétique des Auteurs et des Eléments de Biographies* (Paris, 1937)

Fernand Combaluzier, C.M., prepared this table restricted to (1) a list of authors of articles or letters in the *Annales*, and (2) biographical notices.

1900-1963: *Inventaire Sommaire* (Rome, 1966)

This is an unpublished topical index drawn up by Felix Contassot, C.M., covering the Congregation of the Mission; Saint Vincent de Paul; causes of beatification and canonization; countries, provinces and houses; individual members of the Congregation and the superiors general; miscellaneous items, such as the Vincentian Family; the Daughters of Charity. The *Annales* ceased publication after 1963.

All years have a table of contents at the end of each volume.
