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COMMENCING with this issue of the *Law Review*, the Student Board of Editors is departmentalized. This change is in keeping with the practice of most law reviews. Also, Legislation Notes is a new feature and the space heretofore allotted to Book Reviews has been increased.

Forthcoming works to be published in the *Law Review* include articles by Professor Arthur M. Scheller, Jr., of our law faculty; Professor L. A. Sheridan of the Faculty of Law of The Queen's University of Belfast; Director J. Edgar Hoover of the Federal Bureau of Investigation; Mr. Melvin M. Belli of the San Francisco Bar—also, articles treating of the Nuremberg International War Crimes trial by Dr. Hans Laternser, Rechtsanwalt of Frankfurt/M., who was Defense Counsel for Dr. Arthur Seyss-Inquart and the General Staff and the OKW of the German armed forces; Dr. Herbert Kraus, Professor der Rechte of Göttingen, who was Defense Counsel for Hjalmar Schacht; and Dr. Egon Kubuschok, Rechtsanwalt of Honnef (Rhein), who was Defense Counsel for Franz Von Papen and the Reich Cabinet.

Professor Scheller is writing on the subject of administrative control of Illinois water resources. Professor Sheridan, who was formerly Dean of the Faculty of Law of the University of Singapore, is writing on the subject of trusts and powers of appointment for public purposes which are not charitable.

The Faculty Director's most recent work, "Juristisches und militarisches Denken and Handeln," appeared in *Neue Zeitschrift für Wehrrecht*, Jahrg. 4, Heft 4 (J. Schweitzer Verlag of Berlin).

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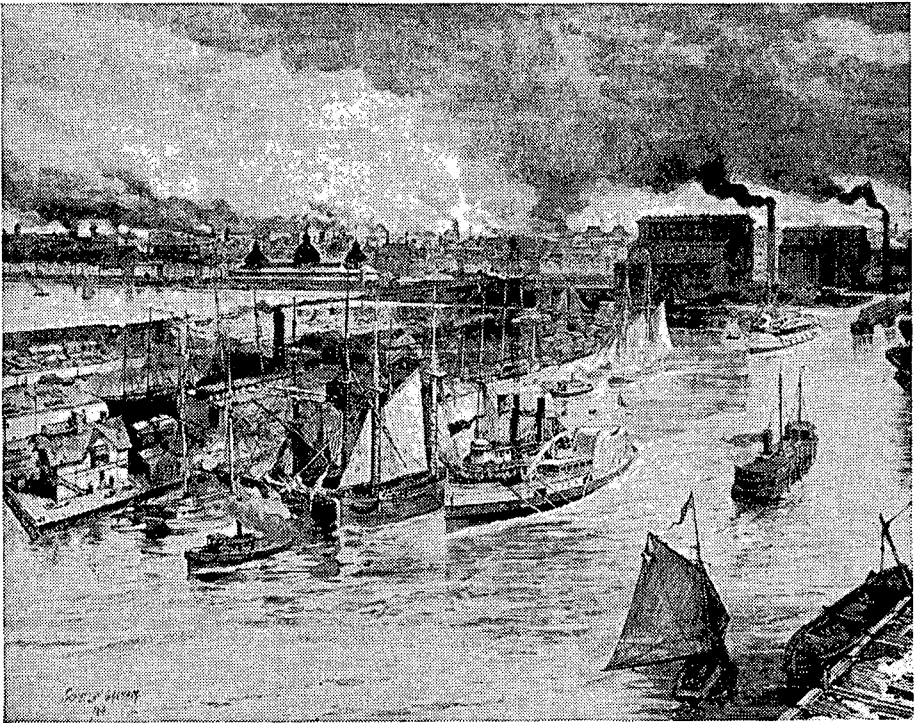
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
